For KIDS trips, a committee of KIDS Board members and prior CDM student participants will select a few to invite for interview; the interview will be with someone from KIDS who will determine those selected for the trip. Anyone attending these trips is expected to travel with the entire group (not on their own). The locations are rural; travel arrangements to and from the hotel are extensive and rough. You may be required to transport some of the supplies in your baggage. Dietary restrictions (religious or otherwise) cannot be managed in these locations. \*Please note that the KIDS organization sponsors some of this cost for attendees. CDM will provide \$500 stipend upon your return.

For Somos Amigos trips, the amount quoted above includes a \$300 program fee to the organization. Room and board is provided by hosting families that live near the clinic. The conditions are rural and living quarters are shared. Dietary restrictions (religious or otherwise) cannot be managed in these locations. *CDM will provide \$500 stipend upon your return-typically covering airfare.*
