# General Practice Residency

# Weekly Schedule

- GPR Clinic (9am-4pm)
- Oral Surgery Clinic (9am-5pm)
- Faculty Practice (9am-3pm)
- OR (varies, generally 4 hour block per patient)
- On-Call (7am-7am + 3 hours)
- Post-Call
- Rotations (2 weeks)
- Lectures

# Typical weekly schedule

- Monday: GPR / OS / FP / on-call
- Tuesday: AM: lecture, PM: OS / GPR / on-call
- Wednesday: GPR / OS / OR / on-call
- Thursday: GPR / OS / FP / OR / on-call
- Friday: FP / on-call (physical diagnosis from 8am-9am in the Summer)
- Saturday: on-call
- Sunday: on-call

**GPR:** your GPR patients

**OS:** OS resident clinic

**OR:** GPR OR

**FP:** GPR faculty practice

**On-call**

# GPR Clinic

- Comprehensive care clinic for your own roster of patients
  - **Medically compromised**
- Cleanings, operative, fixed, removable
- **~1-3 times a week**
- Flexibility in how many patients you see a day, **generally 1 patient every 90 minutes** and **up to 4 patients**
- Experience with **3D digital scanner** for restorative workflow and treatment planning



# Oral Surgery Clinic

- Help students with **consults** and **procedures**
- Help on-call resident with **seeing inpatients** who are transported to clinic for **PANs, extractions, etc**
- Experience with **surgical extractions, alveoloplasty, biopsies, implant placement**



# Faculty Practice

- **Medically compromised** patients
  - Dental clearances
  
- **Special needs** patients
  - Prophyls, fillings, or triage for OR



# OR

- **Medically compromised** and **special needs** patients who **cannot** be treated in the dental clinic under local anesthesia
- **Dental exam, FMX, prophylaxis, and all fillings and extractions** as indicated under general anesthesia



# On-call

- **24 hour shift, ~q6-8**
- **Consults**
  - **Dental clearances on inpatients**
    - PAN and extractions of all indicated teeth
  - **Dental emergencies**
    - Dental trauma
    - Infection
    - Other dental issues
  - **Facial trauma**
    - Fractures
    - Lacerations

- **OMFS inpatients**

- Post-op checks
- Manage overnight
- Pre-round and round



# Post-call

- You get the day after call off



# Rotations

- **Fall: Anesthesia**
  - Shadow anesthesiologist in the OR
  - Intubate patients
  
- **Spring: ENT**
  - Pre-round and round
  - Assist in OR
  - Consults
